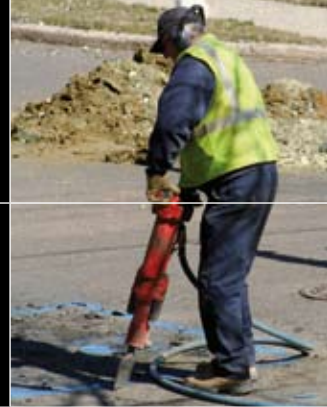


Noise Assessments

The Control of Noise at Work Regulations 2005 requires employers to carry out a noise risk assessment if any employee is likely to be exposed at or above the lower exposure levels of 80dB(A) for 8 hours or more.

What's involved?

How:
